Phonics

In phonics, we have revisited oa, short oo, long oo, ar with a particular emphasis on composing our own sentences with words containing these letters and sounds.

Maths

During our maths learning, we have explored the composition of 9 and 10 by splitting 9 or 10 objects into two groups and counting each part. Two parts make the whole number. We have also compared amounts saying whether it is more/fewer/equal and have practised counting back from 10 to zero. The children have also ordered numbers to 10 and challenge each other by asking them to spot the mistake in the number line.

Topic

As dinosaur detectives, we have looked at lots of images of dinosaurs; naming them and predicting if they were carnivores or herbivores by whether they walked on two or four legs, had sharp or blunt flat teeth, whether they had armour to protect themselves or sharp claws to attack.

In RE we have begun to look into the signs of Spring and the children have drawn pictures of what they hope to see as we move into the season of Spring.

Home Learning Challenge

To go on a family walk and search for signs of spring. What new life can you find?
