Key words

Seed - comes from the flower or fruit part of a plant, from which a new plant can grow.

Root - part of plant that is usually hidden underground. Roots have two jobs: they hold the plant in the ground and they take water and food from the soil.

Shoot - new growth from a seed.

Stem - part of a plant that supports leaves, flowers and fruit. It carries water and food between the roots and the shoots.

Leaf - part of a plant that takes in sunshine to make food for the plant to grow.

Bud - a small growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower or shoot.

Flower - the most colourful part of a plant. Flowers have petals.

Nectar - a sweet liquid inside flowers that insects like to drink.

Habitat - where an animal or plant lives.

Insects - a small animals that has six legs and wings.

Whorl (recap) - a spiral pattern on a snails shell.

Foot - the body of snail.

Mini beasts - small animals that live in gardens.

Damp - a little bit wet.
