Phonics

Due to Mrs Hay visiting Nurseries this week her Phonics Group and Mrs Maguires Phonics group combined to revisit Phase 3 sounds: oa (b-oa-t, soa-p) long oo (m-oo-n, too) short oo (l-oo-k, g-oo-d) ar (far-m, h-ar-d). They have learnt the new tricky words: what when.

In Miss Holiday's group the children have revisited the sounds e u r. They have been focusing on segmenting and blending words that contain these sounds. They been practising reading the tricky words: I the into no go to.

Maths

During our maths learning, we have continued to work on sharing amounts into groups using a one for me, one for you approach and the vocabulary more/fewer/equal/fair /unfair to compare how many.

Topic

Ladybirds came into school Friday morning to find we had two butterflies. Unfortunately, one had a poorly wing. Ladybirds were so excited to talk about the colours and watch how they move. We had such a busy day that I have taken a video of the butterfly flying out of the net for the children to view on our class page.
