## Key words

**Seed** - comes from the flower or fruit part of a plant, from which a new plant can grow.

**Root** - part of plant that is usually hidden underground. Roots have two jobs: they hold the plant in the ground and they take water and food from the soil.

**Shoot** - new growth from a seed.

**Stem** - part of a plant that supports leaves, flowers and fruit. It carries water and food between the roots and the shoots.

**Leaf** - part of a plant that takes in sunshine to make food for the plant to grow.

**Bud** - a small growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower or shoot.

**Flower** - the most colourful part of a plant. Flowers have petals.

**Nectar** - a sweet liquid inside flowers that insects like to drink.

**Habitat** - where an animal or plant lives.

**Insects** - a small animals that has six legs and wings.

**Whorl (recap)** - a spiral pattern on a snails shell.

**Foot** - the body of snail.

**Mini beasts** - small animals that live in gardens.

**Damp** - a little bit wet.
