

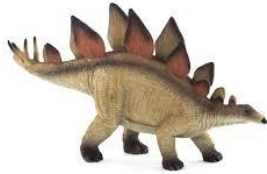

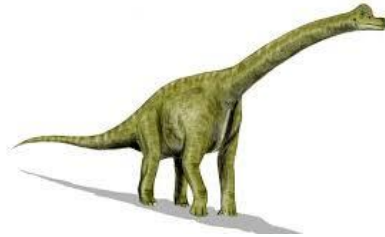

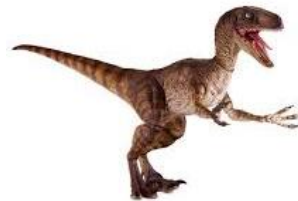

## Key words

**Paleontologist** - a person who looks for fossils.

**Fossil** - Parts of animals or plants found within rocks.

**Extinct** - No longer alive.

**Reptile** - An animal that has scaly skin and lays eggs.

**Predator** - An animal that hunts for food.

**Prey** - An animal that is hunted as food

**Carnivore** - A carnivore eats meat

**Herbivore** - A herbivore eats plants

**Omnivore** - An Omnivore eats plants and meat

**Skeleton** - The bones that make up a body.

**Jaw** - The bones that open and close your mouth

**Spine** - The back bone OR a spike like prickle to defend

**Whorl** - A spiral pattern

**Scales** - A thick, dry flake of skin

**Claws** - Sharp nails that can tear
