

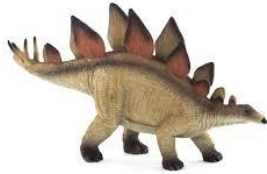

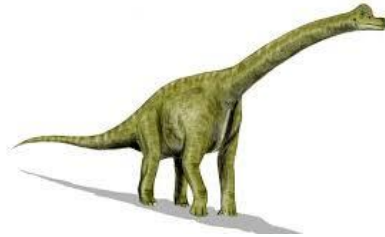

Paleontologist - a person who looks for fossils.

Fossil - Parts of animals or plants found within rocks.

Extinct - No longer alive.

Predator - An animal that hunts for food.

Prey - An animal that is hunted as food

Carnivore - A carnivore eats meat

Herbivore - A herbivore eats plants

Omnivore - An Omnivore eats plants and meat

Skeleton - The bones that make up a body.

Jaw - The bones that open and close your mouth

Spine - The back bone OR a spike like prickle to defend

Whorl - A spiral pattern

Scales - A thick, dry flake of skin

Claws - Sharp nails that can tear
