Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we have been enjoying the lovely Spring weather. We have taken our learning outside and have been drawing spring flowers and bird watching. Our tadpoles are continuing to grow and we fed them cucumber this week. We have noticed their heads are beginning to change in colour and we have been discussing how long it will take for them to begin growing their back legs.



During our phonic sessions, we have revisited the letters and sounds oi and nk and addressed any misconceptions around the nk sound. We have introduced the tricky words do and so. The children are continuing to work on their letter formation and working hard to remember to join the digraphs and trigraphs.

In Maths we continued our learning in the phase Building 9 and 10. We have been consolidating concepts including numbers bonds to 5, combining two groups and saying the number that is one more or one less than a given number. The children have been demonstrating these skills by using ten frames and counters, numicon shapes and recalling number bond facts.
