Homework

Homework will continue to be set on a Friday to be completed by the following Thursday (6 nights). Children who not completing homework within the 6 days will be asked to stay in at lunchtime on the Thursday to complete it. Homework is an expectation of all children and prepares them for what is expected at secondary school, when they start in September. We hope you will support us by encouraging your child to complete this on time.

Homework will consist of:

1 section of the maths workbook (max 30 mins)

1 section of either a reading workbook or SPaG workbook (max 30 mins)

Spellings to learn

Reading - 4x per week and signed in reading record.

PE

PE will continue to be on a Wednesday - please ensure your child has the correct kit. (Black shorts/leggings/tracksuit bottoms, white T-shirt, plain black hoodie and trainers).

FOREST SCHOOL

Forest school will also be on a Wednesday - **children must wear old clothes (long trousers and long sleeves) and will need a warm coat as they will be out in all weathers.**

TRIPS

Our trip this term is to Studland (weather permitting). We will be looking at the impact of climate change on our local area. The cost of the trip should be around £2.50
