Phonics

During our phonic sessions we have been practising reading and spelling longer words with digraphs/trigraphs and adjacent consonant letter blends by chopping them up into syllables e.g. handstand, woodland, seventh, starlight. We are getting incredibly good at writing these within a dictated sentence e.g. She had a sandwich in her lunchbox. We are working towards putting finger spaces between words to replace the syllables.

We become shark experts this week. We have shared non-fiction books and have enjoyed reading a range of stories such as: Shark in the Park and Smiley Shark. Some children have written about sharks and some children have begun to use Year 1 lined paper to practise letter formation.

Books to Love and Books to Learn

As we are beginning to prepare for the end of the academic year, we are beginning to update our book audit. Briefly looking through our records we have a number of books to learn and books to love missing.
