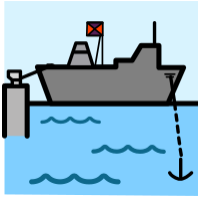
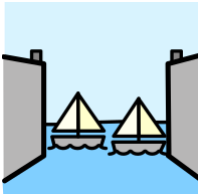

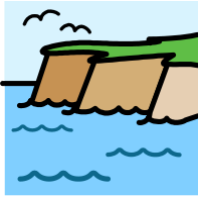
port

a town or city with a harbour where ships load or unload cargo



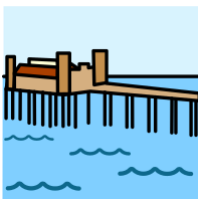
harbour

a tall building with a bright light near the top, and it protects ships from crashing into shore by sending a flashing light out towards the sea

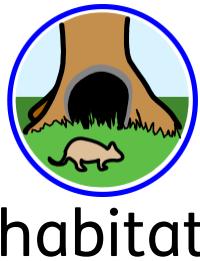

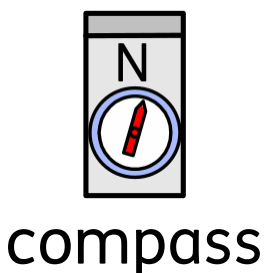
an area of land surrounded by water

an area with houses. More than a village but less than a city



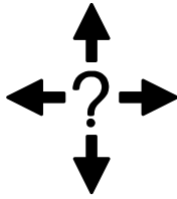
a tool used for finding direction

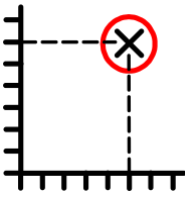
map
