Phonics

In phonics we have begun learning Phase 3 sounds. We have learnt j v w x and we are becoming confident to read words containing these sounds.

Maths

Through number games, we have been counting, recognising numerals and subitising arrangements of up to five objects. Subitising is saying how many without needing to count. By singing 5 currant buns and exploring different arrangements of objects, we have spotted numbers within numbers such as different ways to make 4 and 5. "3 and one more makes 4. 2 and another 2 makes 4. 5 is 4 and 1 more." We have practised, and continue to learn, how to count to 5 on our fingers and count back from 5. To practise at home, encourage your child to show 4 or 5 using their fingers. Is there more than one way? Is it possible to show 4 or 5 using two hands rather than just one?

Topic – Amazing Animals / Nativity

This week we took time to remember those who gave their lives to keep us safe and free. The children were very respectful and showed empathy for others. We talked about why we have poppies and how our poppy money helps injured soldiers and their families.

We also started learning some Nativity songs and we cannot wait for you to hear them!
