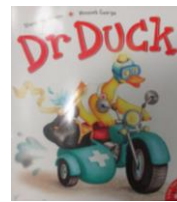
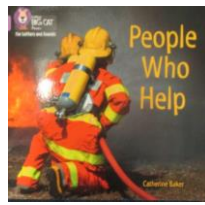

Dear Parents and Carers,



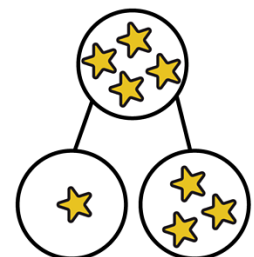
This week we have been learning about Doctors, Nurses and Paramedics; the jobs that they do, the equipment that they use and how they can help us. We have learnt that in an emergency we can dial 999 and ask for the service we need. One of our favourite activities this week has been using our fine motor skills to create emergency vehicles using tap tap art!



In phonics we have introduced the children to the digraphs oa, oo and ar. The children have been practicing using their phonics to write words and simple sentences in their own learning. We are working on reading back our work to make sure it makes sense and that we have all the sounds we hear in the words.



In maths we have been exploring 3D shapes. We have learnt the difference between a 2D and 3D shape. We have been going on shape hunts to find 3D shapes in the classroom. We have also been looking at ways to make 4 and 5 using the part whole model.

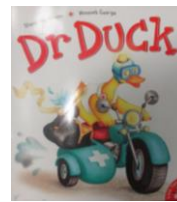
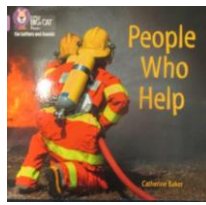
