Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we have been sharing what we have learnt, enjoyed and things we would change about our People who help topic. Please see our discussion on our class page. Also we are moving to a new topic after half term. Our topic next half term will be dinosaurs! The children were very excited to discuss what they would like to learn about.

In phonics we have been reading and writing 2 syllable words that include digraphs. We now know the top-tip of chopping the word up into syllables e.g. b-e-d bed, r-oo-m room, bedroom or f-ar-m farm, y-ar-d yard, farmyard.

During maths, we have explored height, length and the days of the week. Through challenges and questions we have applied our skills to solve problems such as; Who is the tallest/shortest person? How can we find out? How many bricks measure the same height as you? How many bricks do you think you will need to make a shorter/taller tower? Whilst exploring, we have developed our language to talk about, and compare height and length tall taller tallest long longer longest short shorter shortest. Through singing our daily days of the week song we have learned the days of the week in sequence, as well as the vocabulary yesterday, today, tomorrow to describe when events happen.



Home Learning Challenge

In preparation for our new topic, we are asking you to take on a family challenge of creating something for our dinosaur display. This could be a junk model dinosaur that you construct, dinosaur footprints made with salt dough or a fossil you may have found on the beach on a fossil hunt.
