



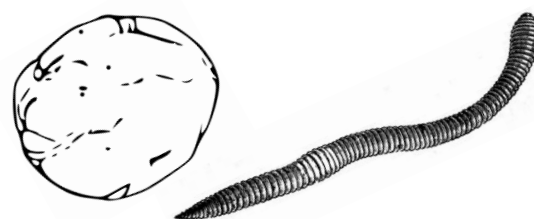

Ahoy me hearties. What a wonderful crew! We have loved dressing up as pirates this week. We have enjoyed exploring under water sea creatures and writing about them using non-fiction texts. During independent learning time the children have chosen their own activities including; making a split pin pirate, building sandcastles, creating pirate treasure maps and creating pirate stories.

Ladybirds learnt a new poem called "Under a stone". Ask us to perform it for you!

Under a stone where the earth was firm,
I found a wiggly, wiggly worm.
"Good morning," I said.
"How are you today?"
But the wiggly worm just wriggled away.



In Phonics we have been reinforcing all the letter blends we have been learning to read and write that can be found at the beginning or end of words: sk nk fl dr bl tr mp cr pl st tr cl nd sp nt tw cr sp st fr pt sl.

In Maths we looked at sharing different amounts. The children explored numbers to 10 sharing golden coins amongst 2 pirates. The children had to identify if the pirates had the same or different amount and decide if the whole number could be shared equally. The children then challenged themselves to look at sharing amounts into groups of 3 and 4.

The children have also been enjoying using a handmade treasure chest with coins created by Ferne in Ladybirds class.
